

FOUR NATIONS ROADMAP - RE-OPENING DATES (Subject to data)

ENGLAND

Step 1

- 8th March:- Primary & Secondary schools open. Exercise or recreation outdoors with 1 other person.
- **29th March:-** Rule of 6 outdoors & outdoor sports, outdoor parent and child groups up to 15.

Step 2

• **12th April**:- (TBC) Gyms open, outdoor attractions, libraries, overnight stays, Nonessential shops. Libraires and community centres to open. Indoor children's activities resume.

Step 3

 17th May:- (TBC) Indoor entertainment, 30-person limit outdoors, 2 households can meet indoors, organised indoor adult sport. Remaining outdoor entertainment including performances. Remaining accommodation to open. International travel review.

Step 4

• **21st June**:- (TBC – No Earlier) Nightclubs re-open. No legal limit on social contact, larger events, no limit on all life events.

SCOTLAND

Level 4

- 15th March Primary children back to school.
- 2nd April:- Stay local
- **5th April** Click & Collect, Homeware stores to reopen, showroom and garden centres, hairdressers and barbers by appointment only. Outdoor contact sports.
- 12th April:- All children back to school.



Level 3

 26th April:- (mainland Scotland, Islands on Level 3 will have the option to go to Level 2) All remaining retail to open and tourist accommodation, libraries, museums, gyms for indoor exercise. Café's restaurants and bars outdoors until 10pm. Limited indoor reopening until 8pm. Shielding expected to end.

Level 2

- 17th May:- Indoor hospitality with less restrictions, cinemas and bingo halls, small scale indoor and outdoor events.
- **Early June 2021**:- (TBC) Level 1 Venues open to 11pm, increased event attendance, more normal hospitality.

WALES (Yet to unveil full roadmap)

- 13th March:- Hairdressers, barber's by appointment only,
- 22nd March:- Garden centres,
- 27th March:- Self-contained accommodation, libraries, organised children's activities.
- 12th April:- Non-essential shops, other close contact services
- No date for hospitality

NORTHERN IRELAND

Currently at Stage 1 Lockdown

- 8th March Partial return of schools for children up to age 7.
- 22nd March Some secondary pupils return to school.

Stage 2 (From 1st April)

• Partial return of schools, 6 people from 2 households can meet in private garden, click and collect, cafes, church services.



• 6 people from 2 households can meet indoors, All children to school, retail fully open, table service in pubs/restaurants, leisure centres open, phased return to offices.

Small wedding receptions and funeral wakes allowed.

Stage 4

• Pubs to reopen with table service. Theatres and cinemas to open, some spectators at sports events.
